# MEd Curriculum & Instruction: Post-Secondary Vancouver, BC (Fall 2012 - Summer 2014)

The Faculty of Education **MEd** program is designed for **working professionals**, specifically practicing post-secondary educators.

## ELIGIBILITY

- Applicants must meet SFU masters admissions requirements. A bachelor's degree demonstrating strong academic performance is expected. Minimum 3.0 CGPA.
- Non-traditional applicants may also be considered. These applicants may have followed an alternate educational path and have extensive experience in an educational or professional setting.
- Candidates require several years of exemplary and varied professional experience.



## PROGRAM FORMAT

This program extends over six terms, beginning in Fall 2012 and concluding in Summer 2014.

Classes meet every second weekend on Friday evening and Saturday at the program location.

## PROGRAM FEATURES

This Master of Education MEd program is offered to students who wish to study current literature and research in education, and who wish to apply this knowledge to educational settings in post-secondary settings.

This two year program is designed to provide an opportunity for practicing educators in post-secondary institutions to investigate current issues, theories, and policies concerned with the contemporary educational scene. It is intended to provide both a background and a stage on which to investigate the social, political, and philosophical conditions of leadership, teaching and learning today in the post-secondary environment. Working with teachers to plan, implement and evaluate their use of these innovative ideas in practice.

The degree program consists of six courses and a culminating comprehensive examination.

- The ability to conceptualize, design and implement a research program for the generation of new knowledge that will satisfy the highest standards of academic and professional review.
