

# INTERNATIONAL READING ASSOCIATION SCHOLARSHIP

## Terms of Reference

1. The International Reading Association Scholarship is a one-semester award valued at approximately \$500 and tenable in the Summer semester.
2. To be eligible to apply for this award, a person must be a full or "part-time" graduate student pursuing studies in literacy education.
3. The criteria for this award are:
  - a) scholarly merit
  - b) potential for future contribution to the field of literacy education.
4. Application is made on the **Application for a Private Graduate Scholarship** form and must be accompanied by:
  - a) copies of all postsecondary transcripts
  - b) one letter of reference from a faculty member familiar with the applicant's work
  - c) a concise outline of the proposed program of studies.
5. The completed application and all supporting documentation must be received by the department of enrolment by **January 30**.
6. The award will be made by the Dean of Graduate Studies, on behalf of the Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee, upon the recommendation of Director of Graduate Programs in the Faculty of Education.
