

PRESIDENT'S Ph.D. RESEARCH STIPEND

Terms of Reference

1. The President's Ph.D. Research Stipend (PRS) is an award currently valued at \$6,250.
2. *Those Doctoral students who commenced their PhD program no later than the January 2009 academic term are eligible to apply.* To be eligible to hold a PRS, the applicant must be registered as a full-time, regular (not “on-leave” or “part-time”) student in good standing in the Ph.D. program at Simon Fraser University.
3. *Applicants must be recommended for the PRS by the Graduate Program Chair of the department of enrolment.* Eligible students may not receive more than one PRS during their doctoral program.
4. Application is made on the **Application for a President's Ph.D. Research Stipend** form located on the Office of the Dean of Graduate Studies website and submitted to the department of enrolment by the deadline date.
5. At the time of application, eligible students must have completed all departmental and University requirements for the degree (e.g., courses, comprehensive or qualifying examinations), except the thesis and, in the case of students in the Clinical Psychology Program, the internship.
6. There is no restriction on PRS recipients receiving income for work performed during tenure of the PRS. Recipients should be aware that some external awards may restrict students from holding a PRS at the same time as the external award.
7. Awards are made on the recommendations of the Departmental Graduate Program Committee to the Dean of Graduate Studies.
