

LIS WELCH GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP IN EDUCATION

Terms of Reference

1. The purpose of this award is to provide support for a student in a Master's or Doctoral program in the Faculty of Education.
2. The Lis Welch Graduate Scholarship in Education is valued at a portion of the earned income from the endowment. Tenure of the award is for one year (three consecutive semesters), commencing in the Spring semester.
3. The criteria for this award are:
 - a) demonstrated academic excellence at the undergraduate level and, if applicable, at the graduate level
 - b) registration at Simon Fraser University in a graduate program in the Faculty of Education
 - c) promise of outstanding achievement at the graduate level with particular emphasis on intellectual ability, originality and ability in research
 - d) when possible, preference will be given to a Canadian citizen or landed immigrant.
4. This award may be held in conjunction with other awards made by Simon Fraser University or other agencies where permitted by those agencies.
5. Application is made on the **Application for a Private Graduate Scholarship** form and must be accompanied by:
 - a) copies of all post-secondary transcripts
 - b) one letter of reference from a faculty member familiar with the applicant's work.
 - c) a concise outline of the proposed field research.
6. The completed application and all supporting documentation must be received by the department of enrolment by **September 30**.
7. The award will be made by the Dean of Graduate Studies, on behalf of the Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee.
