

<p style="text-align: center;">DR. MARGUERITE FAUQUENOY GRADUATE SCHOLARSHIP IN FRENCH</p>

Terms of Reference

1. The purpose of this award is to provide financial support for a graduate student working in the area of French linguistics, varieties of French, French-based Creoles, French literature, or French Studies.
2. The Dr. Marguerite Fauquenoy Graduate Scholarship in French is a one semester award valued at approximate \$600 derived from the interest earned by an endowment. One scholarship is available each year to a graduate student who has completed at least one semester of graduate work at Simon Fraser University at the time of application. If the scholarship is not awarded in the Fall adjudication with tenure in the Spring semester, it may be adjudicated and awarded in the Summer or Fall.
3. The criteria for this award are:
 - a) registration at Simon Fraser University in a graduate program in French
 - b) concentration on French linguistics, varieties of French, French-based Creoles, French literature, or French Studies
 - c) demonstrated academic excellence at the undergraduate level and, if applicable, at the graduate level.
4. This award may be held in conjunction with other awards made by Simon Fraser University or other agencies where permitted by those agencies.
5. Application is made on the **Application for a Private Graduate Scholarship** form and must be accompanied by:
 - a) copies of all post-secondary transcripts
 - b) a concise outline of the proposed or actual program of studies
 - c) one letter of reference from a faculty member familiar with the applicant's recent work.
6. The completed application and all supporting documentation must be received by the department of enrolment by **September 30**.
7. The award will be made by the Dean of Graduate Studies on behalf of the Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee.
