

Paying Admission Deposit for Graduate Students

Paying the \$100.00 Admission deposit is the student's way of telling us they are accepting the offer of admission. It also is necessary to allow them to enroll.

There are two different categories of graduate students and each has the ability to pay the admission deposit in different ways.

The two categories are:

- 1) New or Current students who applied online.
- 2) New or Current students who applied via hard copy application.

Students who applied online can go into their application using their used ID and password and view the status of their application. If they have been admitted they will see the following message:

To accept our offer of admission for this program online, please pay the \$100 admission deposit using a credit card.

To pay by credit card, click on the "Make a payment" link below. This will open a new window. After you have made your payment, please close the window to return to the offer confirmation page. Alternatively, you may pay your admission deposit in person at any campus, by mail, or through your financial institution's internet or telephone banking arrangements. Please give your Student ID number and the Term and program you will be entering. Receipt of your payment serves as acceptance of our offer.

Some departments require an admission deposit of more than \$100.00. The online applicants may be confused by this. It is the department's responsibility to clarify this with the student.

The deposit must be paid before they can enroll. Enrollment for the Fall 2006 semester begins on late July 10th. Students should pay the deposit on or before this date.

New or Current students who applied online

There are 2 ways that applicants to grad studies can access the system to pay their admission deposit and either way allows them to pay using their credit card:

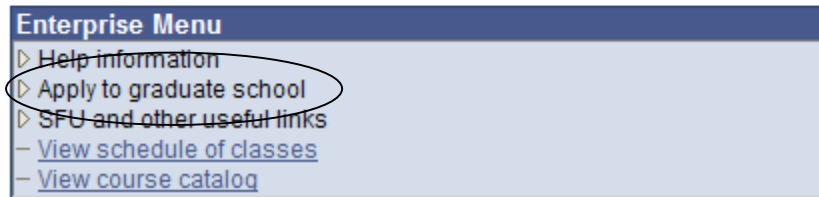
1) Applicants to Grad Studies who have been admitted and who have applied on-line can pay their admissions deposit on-line. To do so, they can go to goSFU – they click on the ‘Apply to Graduate School link. Then they click on ‘apply for graduate admission’.

Then log-in as 'Existing Users – using the userID (GA number) and password that they used to complete the application – or that were sent to them via an e-mail when the application was entered by Grad Studies staff using the on-line application pages. Once there, they can pay on-line with a credit card.

2) Alternatively, the applicant navigates to the Grad Studies home page application to Grad Studies web page: <http://www.sfu.ca/dean-gradstudies/apply.htm> and logs in using her/his GA number and password.

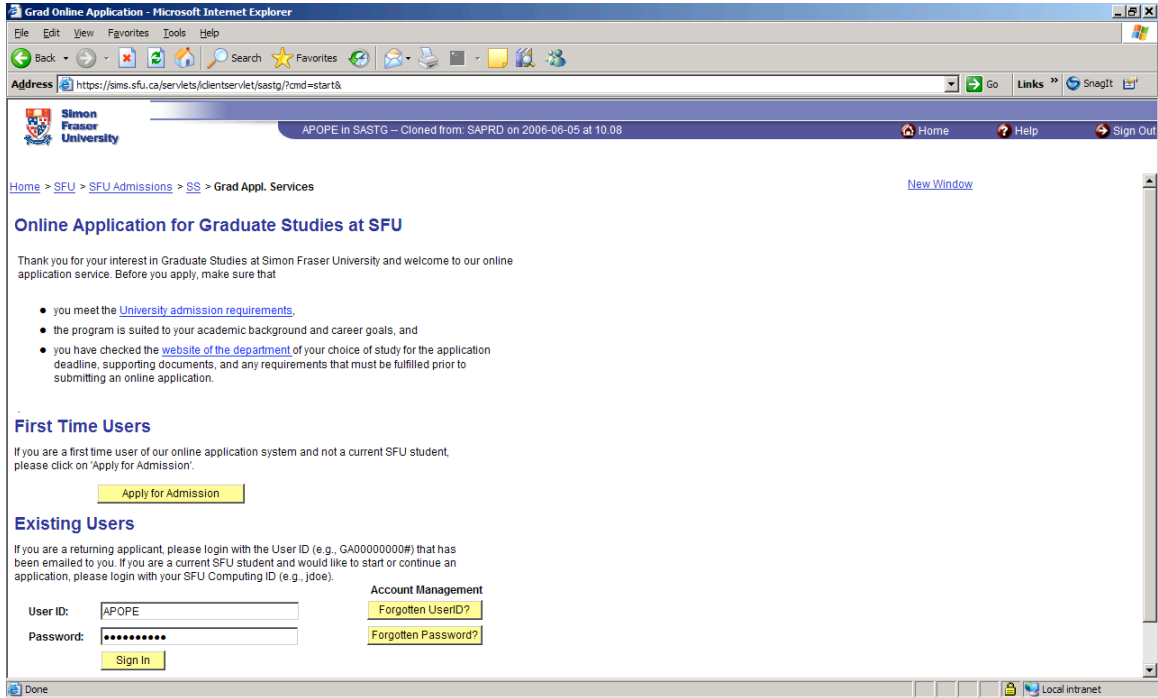

1) Cash, cheque, or money order in-person or by mailing in their payment. They should include their name student number with the cheque or money order.
