Edd GRADUATE FELLOWSHIP
TERMS OF REFERENCE

Please read the following Terms of Reference carefully before completing the Graduate Fellowship Application form.

Three EdD Fellowships are available each year. These fellowships are a one-semester award valued at \$6,250 each (**effective September 2009**). Students are eligible for a maximum of one EdD Fellowship per year.

One of these fellowships will be awarded to an EdD student who meets all of the listed criteria plus one additional criterion: The student must be a resident of a remote community outside the Greater Vancouver Regional District. The two other fellowships may be awarded to any eligible EdD student meeting the criteria.

To be eligible to hold the EdD Graduate Fellowship, a person must be registered as a full-time, regular (not "on-leave") student and must normally have a first-class (≥ 3.50) grade point average. In exceptional cases, other evidence of outstanding ability may outweigh this criterion.

Academic merit is the primary criterion for ranking eligible applicants; the department will advise all applicants in advance if additional criteria will be used. Academic merit is based on grades, research ability, and progress in the graduate program. A recommendation from the Senior Supervisor or the Senior Supervisor and the Co-Supervisor (where applicable), is also required.

During tenure of the fellowship, full-time status is required. A student may not be on-leave during the fellowship and must be paying full fees (not continuing fees) during the tenure of the award.

Application is made on the Application for EdD Graduate Fellowship form (located on the EdD website). The completed form and all post-secondary transcripts must be received by the Director of Graduate Programs, Faculty of Education, **by May 31, 2009**. The EdD Program Committee reviews and recommends a list of recipients. The EdD Program Office will print off your SFU transcript for your application.

All applications and the recommended list of recipients are forwarded to the Dean of Graduate Studies Office. The awards are decided by the Dean of Graduate Studies on behalf of the Senate Graduate Awards Adjudication Committee.
